#### **Payment deadlines**

- **100 days prior to travel:** Full and final payment and Full passenger names (to match Traveller's photo ID) due for all confirmed bookings.
- Late bookings inside 100 days accepted and booked at best available airfare and accommodation rates at time of booking. Payment terms confirmed at time of booking subject to our supplier terms. Late bookings can expect higher costs to be paid.

#### Group airfares booking terms and conditions (Air New Zealand)

Air New Zealand will not provide a refund and the credit is available for one replacement date for the group ie: all the group must continue to travel together on the same dates. Note that Air New Zealand will only provide a credit for future travel in the circumstances of a Government ban being in place, cancellation due to any other reason including concerns about travelling in a COVID environment without a ban being in place, will result in 100% cancellation fee.

Similarly, we would expect accommodation and car hire partners to respond in the same way by holding your bookings as a credit to be used next year. Usually, accommodation cancellation penalties apply within 100 days prior to travel and within 90 days of travel, up to 100% cancellation fees may apply.

#### Norfolk Island Covid19 Operations Plan

- Our local Norfolk Island Emergency Management (EMNI) together with NSW Public Health and our local Health facility (NIHRACS) has developed a Recovery Operations Plan outlining how the Island will be re-opened with responsibilities for local businesses and operators as well as visitors.

- This information is current today in line with our borders opening in these early stages and the information/requirements could likely change anytime especially if the situation continues to be controlled in Australia and Norfolk Island continues to remain Covid 19 free.

#### Late bookings

• Late bookings are welcome however please note price and conditions will vary subject to availability at time of booking.

#### **Domestic Travel Insurance**

- It is strongly recommended that passengers be covered by adequate travel insurance for protection
  against amendment or cancellation costs, travel delay, luggage, rental vehicle insurance excess and
  accidental death and personal liability. For the purposes of travel insurance Norfolk Island is
  deemed to be a domestic destination. As airlines do not accept responsibility for flight delays or
  cancellations due to weather, passengers electing not to take travel insurance do so at their own
  risk for costs or losses sustained.
- **Medical Treatment:** Effective 1 July 2016, medical treatment on Norfolk Island is covered by Medicare as it is on mainland Australia. Emergency medical treatment will be covered by Medicare or your private health insurer. If you need to be medically evacuated from the Island, you will be transferred from Norfolk Island's health facility to the closest, appropriate mainland hospital. The cost of the medivac will be covered by the Australian Government.

#### **Passport & Visa requirements**

From 1 July 2016 travel to Norfolk Island from mainland Australia will be classed as domestic travel. The flights will still depart from and arrive at the **international terminal**.

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection advises anyone travelling between Norfolk Island and mainland Australia will be required to identify themselves. Although passports and visas are no longer mandatory for Australian citizens when travelling to Norfolk Island from Australia, a valid passport continues to be the preferred method of identification.

- We recommend travelling with a passport if you have one, however technically from 01 July photographic identification, for Australian citizens a photo ID such as an Australian driver's licence, will be acceptable.
- It's important you provide us with your full name as it appears on your Passport or Drivers licence to ensure your ticket matches your ID document.
- Those without a passport may experience some delays with manual customs checks

• Those travelling without a passport should also be aware that in the event of a flight diversion e.g. due to inclement weather preventing the aircraft to land on the island, the flight could be diverted to New Zealand. Those passengers without an Australian or NZ passport will not be permitted to leave the transit area at Auckland airport.

#### Foreign passport holders and/or those travelling via New Zealand:

- Normal Australian Customs and Immigration procedures will apply when entry is made from outside Australia (including New Zealand). A passport (valid on entry and departure) is necessary and a visa may be required for some foreign passports. Non-Australian citizens are advised to carry their passport if flying between mainland Australia and Norfolk Island.

#### **Mobile Phones**

You are able to use your mobile phone on Norfolk Island. Mobile phones must not be networked locked as you will need to purchase a Norfolk Island SIM card. SIM cards cost AU\$20 and include AU\$10 worth of call time. Mobile phone SIM cards and recharge cards can be purchased from a variety of stores on the Island. **International Roaming** is available for visitors to the Island who have international roaming activated on their Postpaid Mobiles. International roaming is available with most larger service providers. Roaming is not available for prepaid mobiles. Normally, roaming is already active on your postpaid service, however it may pay to check with your service provider prior to coming to the island.

#### Free Wifi:

Free wifi is available at the Norfolk Island Airport during flight arrival and departure times only.

#### Check-in

#### Air New Zealand

Flights depart from the international terminal at Sydney airport. Check-in is required two hours prior to the scheduled international departure time. Because of this, all travellers ex Adelaide or Melbourne or any other city should seriously consider overnighting in a Sydney Airport Hotel THE NIGHT PRIOR to departure to be safe. Axis Travel Centre can easily organise this Hotel stay. Prices range from \$160 to \$250 per room .

#### **Excess baggage**

- All sporting equipment (carried in addition to the standard 23kg piece included in 'seat and bag' airfares) is now considered by the airline as an additional extra bag
- Extra bags can be prepaid through Axis Travel Centre for \$100 for the first extra piece (per person). For your flights to and from Norfolk Island the total cost is \$150 per piece/per person.

- <u>Or</u> alternatively the extra bag can be paid for at time of check-in, please note this will be at higher cost of \$140 + Per extra first piece (per person). For your flights to and from Norfolk Island the total cost is \$240+ per piece/per person.
- Also note any piece of baggage that weighs over 23kg but less than 32kg and/or exceeds the total linear dimensions (length+width+height) of 158cm (62") will be subject to a further overweight/oversize charge.
